Baby Care Kits

Traditionally summer has been the time that we donate new or just like new items for the Trinity Baby Care Kits Mission Project on behalf of the Lutheran World Relief. Baby Care kits or layettes convey a warm welcome to a newborn and their family in refugee camps, hospitals and villages around the world.

Each layette includes:

- Two cotton t-shirts
- Two gowns or sleepers (without feet)
- Two receiving blankets - square 36 or 45"
- Four cloth diapers – 22 x 27"
- One sweater, jacket, may include a baby cap or sweatshirt with hood.
- Two pairs of socks
- Two NEW bath-size bars of gentle soap
- Two diaper pins
- One hand towel, dark color-preferably

TIPS:

- Sizes up to 24 months may be used.
- Sweaters may be knitted or crocheted from yarn, or made from knit or fleece material.
- You may use flannel material to make receiving blankets. A square cut the width of fabric (usually 36" or 45") easily makes a blanket.
